
Psalm 34:8 O taste and see that the LORD is Good: blessed is the man that trusteth in Him.

It is said of Mr. Mueller that he read through the Bible more than 200 times in his lifetime, and many of those times he was on his knees.

Exodus 33:7, 9 – And Moses took the tabernacle, and pitched it without the camp, afar off from the camp, and called it the Tabernacle of the congregation. And it came to pass, as Moses entered into the tabernacle, the cloudy pillar descended, and stood at the door of the tabernacle, and the Lord talked with Moses.

Moses did not have a written copy of the Word of God as we do – God talked with him face to face as a man speaks to his friend. When Moses met with God in the tabernacle, he was not checking off an item on his agenda for the day. He was participating in a meeting with God. He was discovering How Sweet the Word of God is. While the Israelites watched, Moses met with God, talked to God, heard from God, and the Israelites saw a marked difference in him. SEE EXODUS 33:7-23

NANCY DEMOSS WOLGEMUTH – To be transformed by the presence of God, we must not be satisfied with mere head knowledge of God, or with keeping Him at the periphery of our lives. We must be intentional about stepping away from the hubbub of our daily lives, to commune with Him, listen to Him, and cultivate an intimate relationship with Him.
